*The Spirit of the Lord is upon me,
because he has anointed me
to bring glad tidings to the poor.
He has sent me to proclaim liberty to captives
and recovery of sight to the blind,
to let the oppressed go free,
and to proclaim a year acceptable to the Lord.*

The fundamental Christian belief is that Christ is our God who has come to us in our nature - *in the flesh*. If this is so then the Church is concerned about every aspect that affects the dignity and rights of every human being.

At Camp Hill this service will begin outside the church building with the Blessing of Candles to commemorate the words spoken by the priest Simeon over the child Jesus, "A light to enlighten the gentiles and the glory of your people Israel." New Style Candles

Last Sunday, on the altar at Camp Hill, we started to use a new style of candle, which are not made of wax. They are plastic tubing with a wick in a container of refined oil. This will eliminate the problem of dripping wax and candles gutting in a breeze, which has just about ruined the carpets at Camp Hill and caused nightmares for those who care for the altar linen. It will also eliminate the need to constantly clean the candlesticks. This was made possible by the Ladies Guild at Camp Hill. In the coming weeks, thanks to a generous donation, the Norman Park church will change to this new oil candle. Many thanks to John Wood in adapting the new candles to fit the candlesticks.
