Earlier this week the Parishes & Other Mission Agencies Commission warmly endorsed our application and sent a recommendation for its acceptance by the Diocesan Council.

The DC met on Thursday and gave the final authorization.

The logo and 'trade' name is a new departure for our parish and new milestone in our parish's history and story. The new image builds on our proud past, but recognizes that the world we live in has radically changed – and we need to be a part of that world and not a ghetto of past practices.

So we will now use this new image in our advertising and in alerting people to our presence.

However, the new logo *is also for us*, as a reminder of Christ's command to reach out to others and serve our local community. A new name and a new logo will do nothing if we are not prepared to match the image we are projecting.

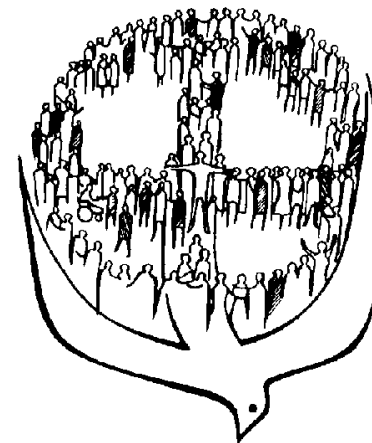
Service for Sunday 27 May - Pentecost Sunday
