Images of the Crucified often have these letters inscribed on them as an abbreviation of Pilate's inscription on the cross of Jesus.

They are the Latin initials for *Jesus Nazarenus, Rex Iudorum* (no J in Latin), which means, Jesus of Nazareth King of the Jews. When we celebrate the Festival of Christ the King we need to remind ourselves of how our Lord understood kingship. In his own words he described himself as shepherd and servant. He demonstrated this in actions, especially in the foot washing at the Last Supper. However, above all of this, his kingship is focused in his greatest act of service to all humanity on the cross. For the wrong reasons Pilate at least got that right when he wrote his inscription. God demonstrates his power, not by pushing people around with imperial authority, but to the extent he goes to save us
