## Festival of the Presentation

*The Child Jesus is presented in the Temple*

*by Mary & Joseph*

### *Welcome.*

Today's festival of the Presentation is the conclusion of the Advent-Christmas-Epiphany cycle of seasons. It gathers together all the themes of these seasons. Advent, the season of waiting and preparation, is seen in the old priest Simeon; Christmas, the season of Incarnation, in Mary & Joseph presenting the Child Jesus in the Temple; Epiphany, the season of manifestation, in the words used by Simeon to declare the identity of the Child.

This great story is only found in Luke's gospel & is his most important story about the birth of Jesus. Today it is worth reflecting on old Simeon receiving the Child into his hands & the joy, fulfillment and completion it gives him. This action parallels our receiving Christ into our hands at the Eucharist. We too are to always receive Christ as the one who is our joy, fulfillment & completion. For this reason the Early Church used his song of praise as a thanksgiving for receiving Holy Communion:

**Now, Lord, you let your servant go in peace:\***  
**your word has been fulfilled.**

**My own eyes have seen the salvation\***  
**which you have prepared in the sight of every people;**

**A light to reveal you to the nations\***  
**and the glory of your people Israel.**

In the Book of Common Prayer this song is known by its Latin title *Nunc Dimittis*.
