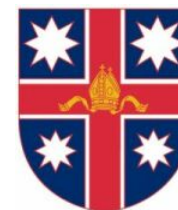

Now is the time for us to meet this challenge personally and as a community.



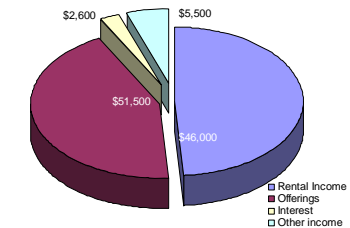

Finances

Current Breakdown of Income:

Rental Income	\$51,500(49%)
Offerings	\$46,000(44%)
Interest	\$ 2,600 (2%)
Other income	\$ 5,500 (5%)
TOTAL	\$105,600

Expenses currently exceed Income



Desired breakdown of Income:

Rental Income (inc Spiritus @ \$600)	\$51,500 (37%)
Offerings	\$75,000 (53%)
Interest	\$ 2,600 (2%)
Other income	\$ 5,500 (4%)
Weddings	\$ 6,000 (4%)
TOTAL	\$140,600

"Giving" from the parish needs to increase by **\$30,000** per annum to survive and grow.
